Dear Four Winds Members,

On June 2, 2020, Governor Ralph Northam signed Executive Order Sixty-Five (65) and presented the second phase of the “Forward Virginia” plan to continue safely and gradually easing public health restrictions while containing the spread of COVID-19. Phase Two modifies the health guidance provided in Phase One; however, it **DOES NOT ELIMINATE THE RESTRICTIONS**. In the case of Four Winds, the change is minimal but we are trying to implement what we can.

Taking into consideration the limits outlined in Executive Order Sixty-One (61), as well as changes presented in Executive Order 65, guidance provided by the Virginia Department of Health and coordination with other private and public campgrounds in the area, the following actions will be enforced starting June 12, 2020:

- The Out of Bounds will reopen in phases. Much of the restaurant reopening is dependent on member/guest adherence to required guidelines.
 - Hand sanitation stations will be established at both door entrances.
 - All food will be prepared as take-out; seating inside the restaurant will be limited in accordance with executive order guidelines.
 - All social distancing practices will apply.
 - Opening date and hours are TBD; this is dependent on supplier availability to deliver food and beverages. This will also influence menu selections.
- The pool and youth center will not open. Opening will depend on Phase Three guidance.
- CDC notices will be posted throughout the campground.
 - Visitors and overnight guests will be permitted. However, please be responsible as to the number of individuals you allow in at any given time.
 - Those visitors and overnight guests without family passes will be required to sign a liability release upon entry.
- All outside workers requiring entry must continue to be pre-approved and coordinated with the Office and Security. The requesting Member will continue to meet their party at the gate to escort them on and off the property.
- Employees will continue to wear masks when coming in contact with the public. It is recommended that members exercise the same precautions.

The present guidelines still do not allow for large party gatherings so the annual meeting and elections will be postponed until guidance allows. However, guidelines for outdoor concert venues are a little more flexible. We will ensure that adequate signage and information is posted to allow for a DJ or band in the pavilion area as soon as possible.

It is imperative that members continue to practice social distancing for the sake of your health as well as the health of everyone who enters the property. Thank you to everyone for your efforts and please continue to remain vigilant.
